

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting January 17, 2019 Special Session to Provide an Update on the Partial
Federal Government Shutdown)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 19-039

1 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and
2 procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing
3 committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono
4 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council
6 with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative
7 Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Appropriations Committee has requested a special session on January 17,
9 2019 at 10:00 a.m. to provide an update on the partial federal government
10 shutdown.

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a
12 special session on January 17, 2019 to provide an update on the partial federal
13 government shutdown with roll call beginning at 10:00 a.m.

14 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of
15 JANUARY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
18 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
20 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
