

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting March 22, 2019 Special Session to Review and Consider the Customs and
Border Protection's Integrated Fixed Tower System)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 19-077

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**


5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council**
6 **with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative**
7 **Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has requested a special session on March 22,**
9 **2019 to review and consider the grant of rights-of-way to Customs and Border**
10 **Protection for the Integrated Fixed Tower System.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
12 **special session on March 22, 2019 to review and consider the grant of rights-of-**
13 **way to Customs and Border Protection for the Integrated Fixed Tower System with**
14 **roll call beginning at 9:00 a.m.**

15 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day of**
16 **MARCH, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
19 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
