

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Confirming the Nomination of Reva Mariah ShieldChief for Appointment as a
Member of the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Governing Body)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-086

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to "provide for, appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and**
3 **prescribe the duties and powers of committees, boards, officers and agents" and**
4 **"to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and**
5 **general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution,**
6 **Article VI, Section 1(b) and Section (c)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 17-026, the Legislative Council approved the Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation Health Care Governing Body Bylaws, which established a Governing Body**
9 **comprised of seven voting members of which six members are nominated by the**
10 **Nation's chairperson and confirmed by the Legislative Council to serve staggered**
11 **four-year terms; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Governing Body Bylaws provide that the Department of Health and Human**
13 **Services executive director shall automatically be part of the Governing Body;**
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 17-026 also provided that an interim Governing Body member's**
16 **term expired when a qualified successor is nominated and confirmed; and**

17 **WHEREAS, Chairman Edward D. Manuel has nominated Reva Mariah ShieldChief for**
18 **appointment as a member of the Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care Governing**
19 **Body, subject to Legislative Council confirmation; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Rules Committees have reviewed the**
21 **nomination and recommend confirmation.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council confirms the**
23 **nomination of Reva Mariah ShieldChief as a member of the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation Health Care Governing Body to replace an interim Governing Body**
25 **member for a term to expire March 8, 2023.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
27 **day of MARCH, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,183.9 FOR; 691.7**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 209.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
29 **by Article VI, Section 1(b), Section 1(d), Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
31 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
32 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
