

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Ms. Allison Ramirez's "Use and Access to O'odham Labor and Water
Following the Gadsden Purchase" Research Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-107

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace morals,**
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Ms. Allison Ramirez, a member of the Tohono O'odham Nation and a University of**
6 **California Los Angeles Department of Sociology student, presented her research**
7 **proposal "USE AND ACCESS TO O'ODHAM LABOR AND WATER FOLLOWING THE**
8 **GADSDEN PURCHASE" to the Water Resources and Human Resources**
9 **Development Committees; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Ms. Ramirez's research will investigate how the accumulation and appropriation**
11 **of water transformed Southern Arizona's agricultural economy since 1854 ; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Institutional Review Board, which is authorized by**
13 **17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8 to review and approve research proposals**
14 **does not have a sufficient number of Board members appointed for a quorum;**
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and Human Resources Development Committees have**
17 **reviewed Ms. Ramirez's research proposal.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that notwithstanding Section 8107 of 17 Tohono O'odham**
19 **Code Chapter 8, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Ms. Allison**
20 **Ramirez's "Use and Access to O'odham Labor and Water Following the Gadsden**
21 **Purchase" research proposal effective from the date of approval of this resolution**
22 **through December 31, 2023, provided that Ms. Ramirez will update the Water**
23 **Resources and Human Resources Development Committees upon request.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that 17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8, Section 8106 (5) regarding**
25 **assurances of confidentiality, informed consent forms, and other provisions of**
26 **Chapter 8 that can be implemented in the absence of an appointed Institutional**
27 **Review Board shall remain applicable to the project.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that ongoing supervision**
29 **of this research be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Institutional Review**
30 **Board when enough Board members sufficient for a quorum are appointed.**
