

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 1 between the
Tohono O'odham Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-150

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to consult, negotiate and**
2 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with**
3 **Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their**
4 **departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or**
5 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1 (f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation**
8 **("Nation") and Intermountain Centers for Human Development, Inc.**
9 **("Intermountain") will allow Intermountain to provide residential and foster**
10 **care services for the Nation's Children In Need of Care for the period of October 1,**
11 **2018 to September 30, 2019; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 1 is in excess of \$500,000.00,**
13 **and so has been reviewed by the Office of Attorney General as required by law; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the funding for this agreement will come from the FY 2019 Department of Health**
15 **and Human Services Division of Child Welfare Tribal Child Welfare Budget 001-**
16 **19-6051; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the agreement and**
18 **recommends its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
20 **approves the Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 1 between the**
21 **Tohono O'odham Nation and Intermountain Centers for Human Development,**
22 **Inc. in substantially the form attached and authorizes the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation chairperson to execute and administer the Agreement.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
25 **day of MAY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,852.3 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 232.3 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
27 **by Article VI, Sections 1(c)(2), 1(d)(3), and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
28 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
29 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
30 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


