

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Setting May 22, 2019 Special Session to Address the Research Proposal from**  
**Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care for Hepatitis C Elimination)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 19-170**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**  
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**  
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**  
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**


5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the Council**  
6 **with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session" (Legislative**  
7 **Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has requested a special session on**  
9 **May 22, 2019 to address the research proposal from Tohono O'odham Nation**  
10 **Health Care for Hepatitis C Elimination.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**  
12 **special session on May 22, 2019 to address the research proposal from Tohono**  
13 **O'odham Nation Health Care for Hepatitis C Elimination.**

14 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
15 **MAY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,965.75 FOR; 395.05**  
16 **AGAINST; 231.1[01] NOT VOTING; and 492.7[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
17 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
18 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
19 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
20 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
