

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O`odham Nation
and the Arizona Department of Public Safety)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-181

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2 negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3 O`odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments. . ." (Constitution of
4 the Tohono O`odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety Tohono O`odham Nation Police Department
6 submits evidence to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory
7 for forensic examination and support in scientific consultations; and resultant
8 expert courtroom testimony for prosecution in tribal and/or federal court
9 proceedings; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety Tohono O`odham Nation Police Department
11 requests approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Arizona
12 Department of Public Safety for the period of one year beginning January 1, 2019
13 to December 31, 2019, for a cost of \$120,957.00 (to be paid either in one payment
14 or four quarterly recurring payments of \$30,239.25) for providing forensic
15 examinations; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the fees to be paid to the Arizona Department of Public Safety pursuant to the
17 Intergovernmental Agreement will be funded by the FY 2019 Department of
18 Public Safety Tohono O`odham Nation Police Department Budget; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Intergovernmental Agreement
20 and recommends its approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council approves the
22 Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Department of Public Safety
23 and the Tohono O`odham Nation for the purpose of crime laboratory forensic
24 examination substantially in the form attached.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O`odham
26 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to enter into the
27 agreement, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval
28 by the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council on the 24TH
30 day of MAY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-
31 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
32 Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O`odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
33 O`odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
34 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
35 (48 Stat.984).
