

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Renewal of and Amendment No. 2 to the Intergovernmental
Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of Tolleson and the
Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-182

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation with Federal, State, and local governments." (Constitution of the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council previously approved the Intergovernmental Agreement**
6 **for Law Enforcement Services between the City of Tolleson and the Tohono**
7 **O'odham Nation by Resolutions No. 15-483, 16-381 and 17-262; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation desires to renew the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of**
9 **Tolleson for two years from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020, to aid in the various**
10 **police services identified in the Intergovernmental Agreement; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the fees to be paid to the City of Tolleson for their services will increase from**
12 **\$8,750.00 to \$10,500.00 per month and will be funded by the FY 2019 Department**
13 **of Public Safety Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department West Valley Resort**
14 **Budget; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Renewal of the**
16 **Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement Services and recommends**
17 **its approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it approves**
19 **Amendment No. 2 to the Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement**
20 **Services between the City of Tolleson and the Tohono O'odham Nation and the**
21 **Renewal of the Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement Services**
22 **between the City of Tolleson and the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to enter into the**
25 **agreement, provided that any amendments shall be submitted for prior approval**
26 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH**
28 **day of MAY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
33 **(48 Stat.984).**
