

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Agreement, Grant No. HT-18-2819 for the Native American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprises Task Force ("NATIVE") and Approving FY 2020 Department of Public Safety City of Tucson HIDTA Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-183

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized to "consult, negotiate and**
2 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
3 **with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their**
4 **departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or**
5 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Council" and to "manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono**
7 **O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation**
8 **and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be**
9 **pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance**
10 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f) and Section**
11 **1(d)(2)); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety was awarded the City of Tucson High Intensity**
13 **Drug Trafficking Area ("HIDTA") Grant, Grant No. HT-18-2819 for the Native**
14 **American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprises Task Force ("NATIVE");**
15 **and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety Police Department has**
17 **negotiated an Agreement with the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking**
18 **Area, Agreement No. HT-18-2819, which is incorporated by this reference, for the**
19 **grant period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019; and**

20 **WHEREAS, this Agreement will be used for the NATIVE Task Force and will allow for overtime**
21 **costs with an effective date of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019; and**

22 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for indirect cost charges; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
24 **approval its FY 2020 City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Budget,**
25 **which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$50,000.00 to be funded**
26 **by the City of Tucson HIDTA-NATIVE Agreement No. HT-18-2819 and**

27 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the City**
28 **of Tucson HIDTA Agreement No. HT-18-2819 and the FY 2020 Department of Public**
29 **Safety City of Tucson HIDTA Budget and recommend their approval.**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 1. accepts the City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Agreement No. HT-18-2819 effective January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019 and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute the Agreement; and**
- 2. approves the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Budget effective January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019 in the amount of \$50,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the City of Tucson.**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH day of MAY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) and Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
