

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Facility License Agreement between the Pima Community College  
District and the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-215**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Constitution vests the Legislative Council with the power "to  
2 consult, negotiate, and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the  
3 Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State, and local governments and other  
4 Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with  
5 private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the  
6 Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** by Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-088, the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
8 Council approved a Facility License Agreement between the Pima Community  
9 College District, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona ("College"), and the  
10 Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") which expired on June 30, 2018;

11 **WHEREAS,** the parties now seek to enter into a new Facility License Agreement ("Agreement")  
12 to provide for a one-year (1) term beginning on July 1, 2018 and ending on June 30,  
13 2019, with options to renew for three (3) more additional one-year (1) terms; and

14 **WHEREAS** the Nation agreed to a payment of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-six  
15 (\$13,596) dollars for the first one-year (1) term ("First Year Payment"), and which  
16 payment for any successive year's term will be annually increased by three  
17 percent (3%) each year; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed the Agreement and  
19 recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
21 Facility License Agreement between the Pima Community College District and the  
22 Tohono O'odham Nation, in substantially the form attached hereto, and  
23 authorizes the Nation's chairman to execute the Facility License Agreement, and  
24 any subsequent renewals.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19<sup>TH</sup>  
26 day of JUNE, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-  
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
28 Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
29 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
30 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
31 (48 Stat.984).
