

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-220

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget in the amount of**
8 **\$57,575.65 was approved by Resolution No. 18-339; and**

9 **WHEREAS, Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee has prepared and submitted for review**
10 **and approval its FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget**
11 **Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference, and which will add a**
12 **new capital equipment line item; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget Amendment No. 1 will**
14 **increase the FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget by \$40,000**
15 **from \$57,575.65 to \$97,575.65; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
17 **reviewed the FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget Amendment**
18 **No. 1 and recommends its approval.**


19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget Amendment No. 1**
21 **effective October 1, 2018, which includes a \$40,000 increase from \$57,575.65 to**
22 **\$97,575.65 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund surplus.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
25 **expend the FY 2019 Executive Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Budget as amended,**
26 **provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for further**
27 **prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
29 **day of JUNE, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


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


