

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress
of American Indians 2019 Mid-Year Conference and Marketplace)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-221

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with**
2 **the federal government and other Indian tribes on all matters within the**
3 **Council's authority (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians ("NCAI") will hold its 2019 Mid-Year**
6 **Conference and Marketplace in Sparks, Nevada from June 23 - 27, 2019; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has worked closely with the NCAI and with Native**
8 **American tribes across the United States to address numerous national issues of**
9 **importance to Indian Country; and**

10 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national-**
11 **level involvement in these issues by participating in the 2019 Mid-Year**
12 **Conference and Marketplace in Sparks, Nevada from June 23 - 27, 2019.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
14 **authorizes Chairperson Ned Norris, Jr. to serve as the Nation's voting delegate**
15 **and Vice Chairperson Wavalene Saunders, Legislative Chairperson Timothy L.**
16 **Joaquin, and Legislative Vice Chairperson Quintin Lopez to serve as the Nation's**
17 **alternate voting delegates in Sparks, Nevada from June 23 - 27, 2019 and at all**
18 **other NCAI meetings and sessions for the 2019-2020 term; provided that the**
19 **voting delegate, alternate, and any Legislative Council representatives attending**
20 **the NCAI 2019 Mid-Year Conference and Marketplace and other NCAI meetings**
21 **and sessions are authorized to present and advocate for resolutions and**
22 **positions previously approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
24 **day of JUNE, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
26 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
29 **(48 Stat.984).**
