10		approval its FY 2019 Cultural Affairs Office Budget Amendment No. 1, which is
11		incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational, personnel,
12		and/or capital line items; and
13	WHEREAS,	the FY 2019 Department of Natural Resources Cultural Affairs Office Budget
14		Amendment No. 1 will increase the FY 2019 Cultural Affairs Office Budget by
15		\$30,318.00 from \$182,334.26 to \$212,652.26; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the
17		FY 2019 Department of Natural Resources Cultural Affairs Office Budget
18		Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20		FY 2019 Department of Natural Resources Cultural Affairs Office Budget
21		Amendment No. 1, which includes a \$30,318.00 increase from \$182,334.26 to
22		\$212,652.26 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund.
