

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget
Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-263

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget in the amount of
8 \$1,499,959.58 was approved by Resolution No. 18-310; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education has prepared and submitted for review and
10 approval its FY 2019 Head Start Grant Budget Amendment No. 1, which is
11 incorporated by this reference and which will adjust personnel and/or
12 operational line items; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget Amendment No. 1
14 will not change the total budget amount of \$1,499,959.58; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
16 reviewed the FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget
17 Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
19 FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget Amendment No. 1,
20 effective October 1, 2018, in the amount of \$1,499,959.58 that shall be funded by
21 the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor.

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
23 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
24 expend the FY 2019 Department of Education Head Start Grant Budget as
25 amended, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted
26 for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH
28 day of JULY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR -0-
29 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
30 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
31 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
32 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
33 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
