

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Donation for National Native American Veterans Memorial)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-268

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to promote, protect and**
2 **provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the**
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and "to manage any funds within the**
4 **exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation (Constitution of the Tohono**
5 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(d)(2)); and**

6 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham men and women have served in all branches of the United**
7 **States military in all military conflicts from the first European contact to modern**
8 **day; and**

9 **WHEREAS, American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians serve in the U.S. Armed**
10 **Forces at a higher rate in proportion to their population than any other ethnic**
11 **group; and**

12 **WHEREAS, there is no national landmark in Washington, D.C. that recognizes the**
13 **exceptional contributions of American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native**
14 **Hawaiians who have served since colonial times; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation honors all past, present, and future veterans by**
16 **appropriating a one-time monetary donation of \$100,000.00 for the National**
17 **Native American Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
19 **reviewed the donation request for the National Native American Veterans**
20 **Memorial and recommend its approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves a**
22 **donation for the National Native American Veterans Memorial in the amount of**
23 **\$100,000.00 that shall be appropriated from the Nation's general fund.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to carry out the intent**
26 **of this resolution.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH**
28 **day of JULY, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
31 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
