

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2020 Department of Public Safety Police Department, U. S. Department
of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program
School Resource Officers Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-304

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2020 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing
9 Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant Budget, which is
10 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$64,417.60 to be funded by the
11 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the U.S.
12 Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program
13 School Resource Officers Grant, and the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety
14 Police Department Law Enforcement Budget; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
16 2020 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice, Community
17 Oriented Policing Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant Budget and
18 recommend its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice, Community
21 Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers Grant
22 Budget effective February 11, 2019 in the amount of \$64,417.60, which shall be
23 funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the
24 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring
25 Program Grant, and the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety Police Department
26 Law Enforcement Budget.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice,
30 Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program School Resource Officers
31 Grant Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
32 submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
