

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2020 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection**  
**Office Brownfields Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-309

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
8 **approval its FY 2020 Environmental Protection Office Brownfields Budget, which**  
9 **is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$137,000.00 to be funded from**  
10 **the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Assistant Agreement Grant under the**  
11 **Brownfields 128(a) Tribal Response Program; and**


12 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**  
13 **2020 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Brownfields**  
14 **Budget and recommend its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
16 **FY 2020 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office**  
17 **Brownfields Budget effective October 1, 2019 in the amount of \$137,000.00 which**  
18 **shall be funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Assistant Agreement**  
19 **Grant under the Brownfields 128(a) Tribal Response Program.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
22 **expend the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office**  
23 **Brownfields Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be**  
24 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of AUGUST, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
