

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting U.S. Department of Justice Office for Victims of Crime Victim Services Set-Aside
Program Grant and Approving FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services
Office for Victims of Crime Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 19-338

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham
2 Legislative Council with the power "[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude
3 agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal,
4 State and local governments . . . on all matters within the authority of the Tohono
5 O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

6 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
7 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
8 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
9 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
10 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
11 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services submitted an application for a
13 U.S. Department of Justice Office for Victims of Crime ("OVC") Victim Services Set-
14 Aside Program grant for supportive services for victims of domestic violence and
15 their dependents; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation received a U.S. Department of Justice OVC Victim
17 Services Set-Aside Program grant award in the amount of \$786,329.00 for the
18 period of April 15, 2019 to April 14, 2022; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Health and Human Services has prepared and submitted for
20 review and approval its FY 2020 OVC Victim Services Set-Aside Program Budget
21 which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$230,062.00 to be
22 funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S.
23 Department of Justice; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
25 reviewed the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim
26 Services Set-Aside Program Budget and recommend its approval.

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the
28 U.S. Department of Justice Office for Victims of Crime Victim Services Set-Aside
29 Program grant in the amount of \$786,329.00 and approves the FY 2020
30 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim Services Set-Aside
31 Program Budget, effective April 15, 2019, in the amount of \$230,062.00 that shall
32 be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the U.S.
33 Department of Justice for the continuation of this grant.

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
3 expend the FY 2020 Department of Health and Human Services OVC Victim
4 Services Set-Aside Program Budget, provided that any amendments or
5 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
6 Legislative Council.

7 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH
8 day of AUGUST, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-
9 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
10 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) and Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
11 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
12 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
13 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
