Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 2(B) of the Tohono O'odham Children's Code, the Children's Court has exclusive original jurisdiction over the termination of parental rights, adoptions, and children's custodianships and guardianships. Beginning January 2, 2008, all cases involving the termination of parental rights, adoptions, and children's custodianships and guardianships shall be heard by the Children's Court. Any of these cases currently filed with the Adult Civil Court shall be transferred on January 2, 2008 to the Children's Court bench. New cases regarding the termination of parental rights, adoption, and/or the custodianship or guardianship of minors should be filed captioning the Children's Court.
