

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting a Small Tribal Community Grant in the amount of \$13,750.64 from the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona's Southwest American Indian Collaborative Network)**

RESOLUTION NO. 09-035

1 **WHEREAS, a multi-year Comprehensive Cancer Planning grant from the Centers for Disease**  
2 **Control was awarded to the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and**  
3 **Human Services; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control encourages its comprehensive cancer planning**  
5 **grantees to seek other funds in order to meet grant goals; and**

6 **WHEREAS, information is needed in order to plan how to increase access to appropriated and**  
7 **effective cancer diagnosis and treatment services; and**

8 **WHEREAS, specific information is needed to map the cancer diagnosis and treatment network**  
9 **between the Indian Health Services, contract health care, AHCCCS and private**  
10 **providers; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the inter Tribal Council of Arizona's Southwest American Indian Collaborative**  
12 **Network accepted the Tohono O'odham Nation grant application entitled Mapping the**  
13 **Cancer Diagnosis and Treatment Network.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
15 **hereby approves the small tribal community grant budget in the amount of \$13,750.65**  
16 **in accordance with the attached budget and Memorandum of Understanding.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any patient information gathered shall remain confidential and**  
18 **maintained by the Department of Health and Human Services.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
20 **Nation's Official, to wit: The Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official**  
21 **are authorized to negotiate and execute this grant, provided however, that any**  
22 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
23 **further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
25 **of JANUARY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
27 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
30 **Stat. 984).**
