

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Rescheduling February 2009 General Session to February 9-13, 2009)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 09-051

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and procedures**
2 **to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees,**
3 **boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1.B.2. of the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
6 **Council provides that "The general session of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
7 **Council shall be held the first full business week of each month."; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council February 2009 General Session and the 71st Annual Tohono**
9 **O'odham Nation Rodeo and Fair are both currently scheduled the week of February**
10 **2, 2009; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to move the February 2-6, 2009 general session**
12 **date to February 9-13, 2009 to allow Legislative Council representatives to volunteer**
13 **during the Rodeo and Fair.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the February**
15 **2009 General Session is hereby rescheduled from February 2-6, 2009 to February 9-**
16 **13, 2009.**

17 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27th. Day of**
18 **JANUARY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,359.4 FOR; 976.9**
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 199.2[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
20 **Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
21 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
22 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
23 **Stat. 984).**
