

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Johnson O'Malley Program FY 2009 Budget Modification/Amendment 1
- Account # 10-1210)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-092

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Johnson O'Malley Program has provided**
2 **direct services to Native American students attending the Baboquivari Unified**
3 **School District, Gila Bend Unified School District and the Division of Early Childhood**
4 **Development; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified the Tohono O'odham Nation of the base**
6 **allocation modification #1 of \$125,827.00 for the FY-2009 Budget, and an additional**
7 **carry over amount of \$38,856.85 with the indirect cost at \$21,528.08 total amount of**
8 **\$186,211.93; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the original estimated FY-09 budget of \$108,056.21 has now been increased by**
10 **\$17,770.79 for a total cost of \$125,827.00 with the an indirect cost of \$19,844.63 which**
11 **has now been increased by \$1,683.45 for a total cost of \$21,528.08; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY-2009 Johnson O'Malley Program Modification/Amendment 1 will now include**
13 **a \$17,770.79 of the base allocation modification #1 and also include the carry over**
14 **of FY08 budget of \$ 38,856.85 for a combined total of \$56,627.64 increased in line**
15 **items 650 (Tuition), 660 (Travel Expense), 711 (Communications), 712 (Gas, Oil and**
16 **Coolants), 722 (Program Supplies), 771 (RM Vehicles), 810 (Professional Services), 812**
17 **(Public Relations).**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
19 **Johnson O'Malley Program, FY-2009 Budget Modification/Amendment 1 reflecting**
20 **the 638 base allocation Modification #81 of \$125,827.00 and the carry over budget**
21 **amount of FY08 of \$38,856.85 for the FY-2009 Budget, with the indirect cost at**
22 **\$21,528.08 for a total amount of \$186,211.93.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairman or Vice-Chairman is hereby**
24 **authorized to negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendment**
25 **affecting the funding or funding levels of the budget shall be submitted for approval**
26 **by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 12TH. Day**
28 **of FEBRUARY, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.5 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
31 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


