

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Budget Amendment #1 adjusting funding levels for a total program increase
of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control and
Preventive (CDC), Comprehensive Cancer Control Planning Grant Award)

RESOLUTION NO. 09-122

1 **WHEREAS, cancer is an increasing health risk for members of the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
2 **it is important to develop a comprehensive plan to address this health risk; and**

3 **WHEREAS, a five year federal grant was awarded to the Tohono O'odham Department of Health**
4 **and Human Services for the project period June 30, 2007 – June 29, 2012; and**

5 **WHEREAS, in addition to the federal award there is a programmatic requirement of cost sharing**
6 **in the amount of not less than 10% of the federal funds awarded, and it is at this time**
7 **the Nation's in-kind services from Community Health, Account 10-1410 identified as**
8 **use of office space, office furniture, telephone, copier and utilities; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's year two federal funding for FY 09 is in the amount of**
10 **\$100,000.00 for the period of June 30, 2008 through June 29, 2009; and**

11 **WHEREAS, there is a program need to add the Supplies – Other line item 721; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation request was approved for unobligated funds in the**
13 **amount of \$83,579.00 from year one (FY 08) to be carried forward to year two (FY 09);**
14 **this carry over amount has then revised the total Federal Grant Award to \$183,579.00**
15 **for FY 2009.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
17 **authorizes expenditures which also adds a new line item 721, Supplies-other; for the**
18 **carry over amount of \$83,579.00 for the attached Tohono O'odham Nation's**
19 **Comprehensive Cancer Planning and Control Grant Budget Amendment No. 1 for**
20 **Fiscal Year 2009 for the period of June 30, 2008 through June 29, 2009 in the total**
21 **amount of \$183,579.00.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit: The Chairperson**
23 **or any designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
24 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level shall**
25 **be submitted for approval by the Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day**
27 **of MARCH, 2009 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,443.95 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; 90.55 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by,**
29 **Section 1 (i)&(j) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
