

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-014

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget in the amount of**
8 **\$1,915,690.01 was approved by Resolution No. 16-351; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review and**
10 **approval its FY 2017 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
11 **reference and will create new line items 7500 Major Capital; 8020 Soil and**
12 **Surveys; 8040 Site Preparation; 8050 Construction Utilities; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1 will**
14 **increase the FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget by**
15 **\$200,000.00 from \$1,915,690.01 to \$2,115,690.01; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
17 **2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1 and**
18 **recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1 which**
21 **includes a \$200,000.00 increase from \$1,915,690.01 to \$2,115,690.01 that shall be**
22 **funded by the Nation's SAWRSA Trust Fund.**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendment will create new line items 7500 Major Capital;**
24 **8020 Soil and Surveys; 8040 Site Preparation; 8050 Construction Utilities.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
27 **administer and expend the FY 2017 Water Resources Department SAWRSA**
28 **Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or modifications**
29 **shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
30 **Council.**

5 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
7 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
