

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Memorandum of Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation
and the San Xavier District)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-063

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council**
2 **with the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments**
4 **and other Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political**
5 **subdivisions, or with private persons or organizations on all matters within the**
6 **authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution, Article VI, Section**
7 **1(f)); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Education, Division of Early Childhood**
9 **Development has submitted for approval a Memorandum of Agreement between**
10 **the Tohono O'odham Nation and the San Xavier District to pay a percentage of**
11 **the reasonable expenses involved in maintaining the facilities of the San Xavier**
12 **Education Department that house the Head Start and Child Care programs; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Division of Early Childhood Development Head Start and Child Care**
14 **programs will utilize the San Xavier Education Department facilities to provide**
15 **services to the children of the Tohono O'odham Nation and cost share the**
16 **operational costs of the space occupied by these programs; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Nation will pay an amount as set forth in the agreement to the San Xavier**
18 **District annually in 2017, 2018, and 2019; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
20 **reviewed the Memorandum of Agreement and recommend its approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
22 **Memorandum of Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the San**
23 **Xavier District and authorizes the Tohono O'odham Chairperson to execute the**
24 **Memorandum of Agreement in substantially the form attached.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
26 **day of FEBRUARY, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;**
27 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
31 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
