

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection
Agency Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-079

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection Agency**
8 **("EPA") Budget in the amount of \$135,000.00 was approved by Resolution No. 16-**
9 **350; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2017 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
12 **reference and which will adjust an operational line item; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Water Resources Department EPA Budget Amendment No. 1 will**
14 **increase the FY 2017 Water Resources Department EPA Budget by \$33,302.53 from**
15 **\$135,000.00 to \$168,302.53; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
17 **FY 2017 Water Resources Department EPA Budget Amendment No. 1 and**
18 **recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2017 Water Resources Department EPA Budget Amendment No. 1, which**
21 **includes a \$33,302.53 increase from \$135,000.00 to \$168,302.53 that shall be**
22 **funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
25 **expend the FY 2017 Water Resources Department EPA Budget as amended,**
26 **provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted to**
27 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.**


