**(Accepting U.S. Department of Justice Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation**  
**Violence Against Women Tribal Governments Program Grant and Approving FY 2017**  
**Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services CTAS DOJ Violence**  
**Against Women Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-080**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2                   **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**  
3                   **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4                   **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5                   **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6                   **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services ("TODHHS")**  
8                   **submitted an application to the U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ") for a**  
9                   **Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation ("CTAS"), Violence Against Women**  
10                  **Tribal Governments Program Grant to provide crisis intervention for women**  
11                  **who are victims/survivors of domestic violence and to educate the community**  
12                  **on domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking; and**

13   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received a CTAS Violence Against Women Tribal**  
14                  **Governments Program Grant (Grant No. 2016-TW-AX-0009) in the amount of**  
15                  **\$900,000.00 for a three-year period from October 1, 2016 through September 30,**  
16                  **2019; and**

17   **WHEREAS, the TODHHS prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 CTAS**  
18                  **DOJ Violence Against Women Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in**  
19                  **the amount of \$300,000.00 to be funded by the Nation's General Fund pending**  
20                  **reimbursement from the U.S. Department of Justice; and**

21   **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and the Budget and Finance Committees have**  
22                  **reviewed the FY 2017 TODHHS CTAS DOJ Violence Against Women Budget and**  
23                  **recommend its approval.**

24   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**  
25                  **U.S. Department of Justice, Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation ("CTAS"),**  
26                  **Violence Against Women Tribal Governments Program Grant for \$900,000.00**  
27                  **and approves the FY 2017 TODHHS CTAS DOJ Violence Against Women Budget, in**  
28                  **the amount of \$300,000.00 that shall be funded by the Nation's General Fund**

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Tohono  
4 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official to administer and  
5 expend the FY 2017 TODHHS CTAS DOJ Violence Against Women Budget,  
6 provided, however, that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted to  
7 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.

8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>  
9 day of MARCH, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;  
10 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
11 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
12 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
13 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
14 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
