

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting U.S. Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring
Program Grant no-cost extension and Approving FY 2017 Department of Public
Safety DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-105

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") was awarded the United States
8 Department of Justice ("DOJ"), Community Oriented Policing Service ("COPS")
9 Hiring Program Grant, Award No. 2013UMWX0010, effective September 1, 2013
10 through August 31, 2016, in the amount of \$125,000.00 which was accepted by
11 Resolution No. 14-062; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the DOJ granted a 30-month no-cost extension of the COPS Hiring Program Grant
13 effective August 31, 2016 to February 28, 2018; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety ("DPS") prepared and submitted for review and
15 approval its FY 2017 DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant Budget, which is
16 incorporated by reference, in the amount of \$125,000.00 to be funded from the
17 DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the
19 FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant Budget and recommend its
20 approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the
22 30-month COPS Hiring Program Grant no-cost extension effective August 31, 2016
23 through February 28, 2018, and approves the FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring
24 Program Grant Budget, effective September 1, 2016, in the amount of \$125,000.00.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
26 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
27 expend the FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring Program Grant Budget, provided any
28 amendments or modifications shall be submitted to the Tohono O'odham
29 Legislative Council for prior approval.




