

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice, Office of
Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program, Homeland Security Grant Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-106

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ") awarded the Tohono O'odham Nation**
8 **("Nation") a Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") Hiring Program**
9 **Homeland Security Grant, Award No. 2014UMWX0024, effective September 1, 2014**
10 **through August 31, 2017, in the amount of \$125,000.00 which was accepted by**
11 **Resolution No. 14-545; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety ("DPS") has prepared and submitted for review**
13 **and approval its FY 2017 DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant**
14 **Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$125,000.00 to**
15 **be funded from the DOJ COPS Hiring Program, Homeland Security Grant; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
17 **FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant Budget and**
18 **recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant Budget,**
21 **effective September 1, 2016.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
24 **expend the FY 2017 DPS DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant**
25 **Budget, provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be**
26 **submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
28 **day of MARCH, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
31 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
32 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
33 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
