

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Law Enforcement Budget
Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-107

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety ("DPS"), Law Enforcement Budget in the**
8 **amount of \$7,861,155.24 was approved by Resolution No. 16-322; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the DPS prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 Law**
10 **Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference**
11 **and which will adjust personnel and operational line items; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 DPS Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1 does not affect the**
13 **total base budget approved for FY 2017; and**


14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
15 **FY 2017 DPS Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its**
16 **approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2017 DPS Law Enforcement Budget Amendment No. 1 which does not affect the**
19 **total base budget approved for FY 2017.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
22 **expend the FY 2017 DPS Law Enforcement Budget as amended, provided however,**
23 **that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted to the Tohono**
24 **O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
26 **day of MARCH, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
