

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services, Tribal Food
Distribution Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-117

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to**
3 **appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided**
4 **that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or**
5 **budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d) (3)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Health and Human Services ("DHHS"), Tribal Food**
8 **Distribution Program Budget in the total amount of \$86,372.00 was approved by**
9 **Resolution No. 16-322; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Program prepared and submitted for review**
11 **and approval its FY 2017 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
12 **reference, and which will (1) adjust operational line items; and (2) Creates new**
13 **line items 7000 Office Supplies and 7420 RM Building; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Program Budget Amendment No. 1,**
15 **will decrease the FY 2017 DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Program Budget by**
16 **\$3,425.00 from \$86,372.00 to \$82,947.00; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and the Budget and Finance Committees have**
18 **reviewed the FY 2017 DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Budget Amendment No. 1**
19 **and recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **FY 2017 DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Budget Amendment No. 1, which**
22 **includes a \$3,425.00 decrease from \$86,372.00 to \$82,947.00 that shall be**
23 **returned to the Nation's general fund.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amendment will (1) adjust operational line items; and (2)**
25 **Creates new line items 7000 Office Supplies and 7420 RM Building.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
28 **expend the FY 2017 DHHS Tribal Food Distribution Budget as amended,**

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provided that further amendments or modifications shall be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for prior approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH day of MARCH, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
