

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime Grant Award No. 2016-VR-GX-K008 and Approving the FY 2017 Office of the Prosecutor Tohono O'odham Nation Victim Witness Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-136**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to  
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided  
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or  
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime has awarded the  
8 Tohono O'odham Nation, Office of the Prosecutor Grant Award No. 2016-VR-GX-  
9 K008 in the amount of \$450,000.00 for a three year period beginning October 1,  
10 2016 and ending September 30, 2019; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Office of the Prosecutor has prepared and submitted for review and  
12 approval its FY 2017 Tohono O'odham Nation Victim Witness Program Budget,  
13 which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$87,080.23 to be  
14 funded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime Grant  
15 Award No. 2016-VR-GX-K008; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the  
17 U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime Grant Award and the FY  
18 2017 Office of the Prosecutor Tohono O'odham Nation Victim Witness Program  
19 Budget and recommend their approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the  
21 U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime Grant Award No. 2016-VR-  
22 GX-K008 in the amount of \$450,000.00.

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2017  
24 Office of the Prosecutor Tohono O'odham Victim Witness Program Budget, in  
25 the amount of \$87,080.23, which shall be funded by the U.S. Department of  
26 Justice, Office for Victims of Crime Grant Award No. 2016-VR-GX-K008.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono  
28 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to  
29 administer and expend the FY 2017 Office of the Prosecutor Tohono O'odham

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1 Nation Victim Witness Program Budget, provided that any amendments or  
2 modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham  
3 Legislative Council.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup>  
5 day of APRIL, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-  
6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
7 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), 1(d)(3) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,  
8 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting  
9 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
10 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
