

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit a FY 2017 Indian
Community Development Block Grant Application for New Housing Construction
to the Department of Housing and Urban Development and Confirming
Compliance with Citizen Participation Requirements)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-165

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2 the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,
3 morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its
4 members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally
6 designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing
7 Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-
8 330, 110 Stat. 4106 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the
9 Indian Housing Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate and expand
10 affordable housing; and

11 **WHEREAS,** TOKA is a "tribal organization" that has been determined eligible to apply directly
12 for Indian Community Development Block Grant ("ICDBG") funds by the U.S.
13 Housing and Urban Development Southwest Office of Native American Programs
14 ("HUD SWONAP"), provided that the Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes it to do
15 so on its behalf (25 U.S.C. § 450b; 24 C.F.R. § 1003.5); and

16 **WHEREAS,** the TOKA wishes to continue providing new affordable housing to meet the needs
17 of the community members by submitting a FY 2017 ICDBG application for
18 \$2,500,000 and leveraging those funds with Indian Housing Block Grant funds for
19 the construction of 15 low-income single-family housing units to serve and
20 improve the quality of life for tribal community members; and

21 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA") that prescribes application
22 requirements states there must be a current, in effect, tribal resolution
23 confirming compliance with ICDBG Citizen Participation requirements and
24 authorizing the submission of the application by the TOKA; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Nation held public meetings to discuss the ICDBG program, eligible activities
26 including the proposed project, allowed public comments, and made
27 modifications to the application as necessary in compliance with 24 CFR
28 1003.604(a); and

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 04-01-17, the TOKA Board of Directors authorized the TOKA's**
2 **submission of a FY 2017 ICDBG application; and**

3 **WHEREAS, after the TOKA presented to and reviewed its FY 2017 ICDBG application with the**
4 **Legislative Housing Committee, the Committee recommended authorizing the**
5 **TOKA to submit its FY 2017 ICDBG application.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 7 **1. the TOKA is authorized to submit a FY 2017 application for HUD ICDBG**
8 **funding in the amount of \$2,500,000 and leverage funds with Indian**
9 **Housing Block Grant to construct 15 new housing units; and**
10 **2. the Nation confirms it has complied with the Citizen Participation**
11 **requirements of 24 CFR 1003.604 .**

12 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs**
13 **the Nation's Chairperson to execute all documents necessary to submit and**
14 **accept if awarded the TOKA's FY 2017 application for HUD ICDBG funds.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH**
16 **day of APRIL, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
19 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
21 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
