

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
Administration Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-185

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety, Tribal Employment Rights Office**
8 **Administration Budget in the amount of \$318,364.31 was approved by Resolution**
9 **No. 16-322; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2017 Tribal Employment Rights Office Administration Budget**
12 **Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference, which will (1)**
13 **establishes new operational line items; and (2) increases operational line items;**
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
16 **Administration Budget Amendment No. 1 will also increase the Department of**
17 **Public Safety FY 2017 Tribal Employment Rights Office Budget by \$145,000.00**
18 **from \$318,364.31 to \$463,364.31; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees**
20 **have reviewed the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights**
21 **Office Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
23 **FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
24 **Administration Budget Amendment No. 1, establishes new operational line items**
25 **and includes a \$145,000.00 increase from \$318,364.31 to \$463,364.31 that shall be**
26 **funded by the Tribal Employment Rights Office Commission Revenue Fee fund.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
28 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
29 **expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office**
30 **Administration Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or**
31 **modifications shall be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**
32 **prior approval.**




