

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the 12 month Extension of the U.S. Department of Justice, Community
Oriented Policing Services, Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333 and the
FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Department of Justice, Community Oriented
Policing Services, Technology Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-188

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety ("DPS") Tohono O'odham Police Department was**
8 **awarded the U.S. Department of Justice ("USDOJ"), Community Oriented Policing**
9 **Services ("COPS"), Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333 in the amount**
10 **of \$100,000.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the USDOJ/COPS Technology Program Grant was accepted by the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 11-096; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the DPS Tohono O'odham Police Department applied for and was awarded a grant**
14 **extension, accepted by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 13-**
15 **025; and a second extension was applied for and approved by Resolution No. 14-**
16 **329; and a third no-cost grant extension was applied for and approved by**
17 **Resolution No, 15-266; and**

18 **WHEREAS, DPS requested a fourth extension from the USDOJ/COPS Office and has been**
19 **approved for a 12 month no-cost extension for the grant period of June 16, 2016**
20 **through June 15, 2017; and**

21 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**
23 **USDOJ/COPS Technology Program Grant extension and the FY 2017 Department**
24 **of Public Safety Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services,**
25 **Technology Program Budget and recommend their approval.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the 12**
27 **month no-cost extension for the U.S. Department of Justice Programs,**
28 **Community Oriented Policing Services, Technology Program Award No.**
29 **2010CKWX0333 from June 16, 2016 through June 15, 2017.**

4 which shall be funded via pending reimbursement from the Grantor.

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
7 expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety Department of Justice,
8 Community Policing Services, Technology Program Budget, provided that any
9 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
10 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH
12 day of MAY, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-
13 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
14 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
15 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
17 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
