

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Memorandum of Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation
and the Federal Bureau of Investigation Regarding Fingerprint Submission
for Non-criminal Justice Purposes)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-189

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation (Nation) With Federal, State, and local governments..."**
4 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Human Resources Department ("Department")**
6 **requires the ability to perform background checks on prospective employees**
7 **that require fingerprint submission to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and**


8 **WHEREAS, the Department has submitted for approval this Memorandum of Agreement**
9 **between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Federal Bureau of Investigation**
10 **Regarding Fingerprint Submission for Non-criminal Justice Purposes; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed this Memorandum**
12 **Of Agreement and recommends its approval.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves this**
14 **Memorandum of Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Federal**
15 **Bureau of Investigation Regarding Fingerprint Submission for Non-criminal**
16 **justice purposes and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute it in**
17 **substantially the form attached.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
19 **day of MAY, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,770.8 FOR; -0-**
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 250.6 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
21 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
22 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
