

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-201

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer
6 or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety
7 bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all
8 expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other
9 authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** Per Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-368 the Baboquivari
12 District was allocated gaming revenues in the amount of \$2,178,486.42; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-458 approved the FY
14 2017 Baboquivari District Administration Budget in the amount of \$682,295.92;
15 and

16 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2017-B-39 the Baboquivari
17 District has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2017
18 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 1 which will (1)
19 Increase and decrease Personnel and Operational Line Items and (2) will not
20 affect the overall FY 2017 Baboquivari District Administration Budget total of
21 \$682,295.92 and nor will it affect overall Baboquivari District Budget from
22 \$2,377,711.46; and

23 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed FY 2017 Baboquivari District-
24 Administration Amendment No. 1 and recommends its approval.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves FY
26 2017 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 1 which will
27 (1) Increase and decrease Personnel and Operational Line Items and (2) will not
28 affect the overall FY 2017 Baboquivari District Administration Budget total of
29 \$682,295.92 and nor will it affect overall Baboquivari District Budget from
30 \$2,377,711.46.

31 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
32 District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the
33 budget, provided that any modification or amendments shall be submitted for
34 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
