

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Pisinemo District Mining Royalties Budgets)

RESOLUTION NO. 17-204

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,
3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer
6 or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety
7 bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all
8 expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other
9 authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-110, Approved
12 Apportionment of Mining Royalties by Equal Distribution, and whereby
13 Pisinemo District was allocated \$115,253.30; and

14 **WHEREAS,** by Pisinemo District Council Resolution Nos. 17-P-10 and 17-P-11 the Pisinemo
15 District approved to Carryover FY 16 Mining Royalties and has prepared and
16 submitted for review and approval its FY 2017 Pisinemo Community Mining
17 Royalties Budget in the amount of \$3,779.17 and its FY 2017 Kupk/Dirtburn
18 Community Mining Royalties Budget in the amount of \$3,926.01; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the attached budgets and
20 recommends their approval.


21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves FY
22 2017 Pisinemo Community Mining Royalties Budget in the amount of \$3,779.17
23 and the FY 2017 Kupk/Dirtburn Community Mining Royalties Budget in the
24 amount of \$3,926.01 utilizing FY2016 carryovers of Mining Royalties.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
26 District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the
27 FY 2017 Pisinemo and Kupk/Dirtburn Community Mining Royalties Budgets
28 provided that any modifications or amendments shall be submitted for prior
29 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH**
31 **day of MAY, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0-**
32 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
33 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
34 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
35 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**


