

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Institute of Museum and Library Sciences Native American/Native
Hawaiian Museum Service Grant Award No. MN-00-16-0033-16 and the FY 2017
Department of Natural Resources Cultural Center & Museum Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-217

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources was awarded the Institute of Museum and
8 Library Services ("IMLS") Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Service
9 Grant Award No. MN-00-16-0033-16 in the amount of \$49,490.00 to be expended
10 between September 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the grant funds shall fund the Tohono O'odham Nation's 2017 Himdag Ki:
12 Community Engagement and Audience Building Campaign; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources has prepared and submitted for review
14 and approval its FY 2017 Cultural Center & Museum Budget, which is
15 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$49,490.00 to be funded via
16 reimbursement by IMLS; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Cultural Preservation and the Budget and Finance Committees have
18 reviewed the IMLS Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Service Grant
19 Award and the FY 2017 Department of Natural Resources Cultural Center &
20 Museum Budget and recommend their approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
22 approves the IMLS Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Service Grant
23 Award No. MN-00-16-0033-16 in the amount of \$49,490.00 which shall be funded
24 via reimbursement by Grantor.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
26 O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to
27 administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Natural Resources Cultural
28 Center & Museum Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications
29 shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
30 Council.
