

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing Execution of Gaming Compact Negotiation Agreements)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-218

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power to “consult, negotiate and**
2 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation**
3 **with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their**
4 **departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private persons or**
5 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O’odham**
6 **Council” (Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f));**
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-562, the Tohono O’odham Nation approved and authorized**
9 **the Nation’s chairman to enter into the Tohono O’odham Nation-State of Arizona**
10 **Gaming Compact (the “Compact”), and on December 4, 2002, the Nation’s**
11 **chairman entered into the Compact with the State of Arizona; and**

12 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 07-431, the Legislative Council authorized the Chairperson of**
13 **the Nation and members of the Legislative Commerce Committee to serve on the**
14 **Tohono O’odham Nation Gaming Negotiating Committee (“Gaming Negotiating**
15 **Committee”) in order to negotiate amendments to the Compact with the State of**
16 **Arizona, provided that such amendments be submitted to the Legislative**
17 **Council for final approval; and**

18 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 17-209, the Legislative Council approved an Agreement to**
19 **Amend Compact between the Tohono O’odham Nation and the State of Arizona,**
20 **and the Gaming Negotiating Committee recommends that the Nation enter the**
21 **Confidentiality Agreement with the State of Arizona and an additional**
22 **agreement with Arizona tribes (collectively, the “Compact negotiation**
23 **agreements”), which are incorporated by this reference in substantially the**
24 **form presented to the Legislative Council, in order to enter additional Compact**
25 **negotiations.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council approves**
27 **and authorizes the Nation’s chairman to timely execute and deliver the Compact**
28 **negotiation agreements; provided that nothing in this resolution or in the**
29 **Compact negotiation agreements shall be deemed a waiver of the Nation’s**
30 **sovereign immunity and any Compact amendment negotiated by the Gaming**
31 **Negotiating Committee shall be subject to final approval by Legislative Council**
32 **resolution.**



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
1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 1ST

4 by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
5 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
7 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
