

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program
Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-219

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation...and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget in the**
8 **amount of \$4,444,861.71 was approved by Resolution No. 16-326; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
10 **approval its FY 2017 638 Corrections Program Budget Amendment No. 1, which is**
11 **incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and personnel**
12 **line items; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget**
14 **Amendment No. 1 will decrease the FY 2017 638 Corrections Program Budget by**
15 **\$10,222.18 from \$4,444,861.71 to \$4,434,639.53 due to the adjustment of the**
16 **indirect cost charges; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
18 **2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget Amendment**
19 **No. 1 and recommend its approval.**


20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **FY 2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget**
22 **Amendment No. 1 which includes a decrease of indirect cost charges by**
23 **\$10,222.18 reducing the overall budget from \$4,444,861.71 to \$4,434,639.53.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
26 **administer and expend the FY 2017 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections**
27 **Program Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or**
28 **modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
29 **Legislative Council**


30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 1ST**

33 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
34 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
35 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
36 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
