

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2017 Amendment to reduce applicable Indirect Cost Programs  
Self-Governance Budgets)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-231**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to  
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided  
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or  
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and  
7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Tohono O'odham Nation Indirect Cost Programs Self-Governance  
8 Budgets Human Resources Department and the Department of Information and  
9 Technology was approved by Resolution No. 16-525; and  
10 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Executive Branch Office of Attorney General budget in the amount of  
11 \$1,989,446.32 was approved by Resolution No. 16-322 and amendment No. 1 was  
12 approved by Resolution No. 16-583 increasing the FY 2017 budget in the amount  
13 of \$545,000 for a total budget amount of \$2,534,446.32; and  
14 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Human Resources budget in the amount of \$1,796,905.84 was  
15 approved by Resolution No. 16-322 and was consolidated with the FY 2017  
16 Indirect Cost Programs Self Governance budget for Human Resources approved  
17 by Resolution No. 16-525 in the amount of \$1,423,945.29 for a total budget of  
18 \$3,220,851.13; and  
19 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2017 Department of Information Technology Budget in the amount of  
20 \$2,345,174.66 by Resolution No. 16-322 and was consolidated with the FY 2017  
21 Indirect Cost Programs Self Governance budget for Department of Information  
22 Technology approved by Resolution No. 16-525 in the amount of \$3,772,786.60  
23 for a total budget of \$6,117,961.26; and  
24 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources, Office of Attorney General and Department of  
25 Information of Technology Departments have prepared and submitted for  
26 review its FY 2017 Indirect Cost Programs amendments which are incorporated  
27 by this reference will (1) decrease operational and applicable capital line items;  
28 and (2) decrease the budgets by a total amount of \$1,155,381.84; and  
29 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services, Human Resources Development, Domestic  
30 Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative Council have  
31 reviewed the FY 2017 Budget amendment for the Indirect Cost Programs Self-  
32 Governance budgets and recommend its approval.

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the decrease of the FY 2017 Indirect Cost Programs Self-Governance Budget Amendments for a total of \$1,155,381.84 as follows:**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup> day of JUNE, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
