

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department One Stop Division  
Related Resolution Nos. 15-218, 16-242, and 16-518)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-275**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to  
3 appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided  
4 that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or  
5 budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation, Article VI Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is authorized "to consult, negotiate and conclude  
8 agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with  
9 Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their  
10 departments, agencies, or political subdivisions" (Constitution of the Tohono  
11 O'odham Nation Article VI, Section 1(f)); and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Arizona Department of Economic Security funds, through the Workforce  
13 Innovation and Opportunity Act, Title 1B, employment and training programs  
14 operated by the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department One Stop  
15 Division; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement  
17 with the Arizona Department of Economic Security Workforce Innovation and  
18 Opportunity Act, Title 1B for July 1, 2015-June 30, 2020 (Resolution No. 15-441);  
19 and

20 **WHEREAS,** Legislative Council Resolution Nos. 15-218 "Approving FY2016 Budget with the  
21 Arizona Department of Economic Security for the One Stop Division of the  
22 Education Department", 16-242 "Approving FY 2017 Tohono O'odham Nation's  
23 One Stop Division's Budgets for PY Dislocated Worker, FY Dislocated Worker,  
24 Adult/Youth Admin, PY Youth, FY Adult Admin, PY Adult and FY Adult", and 16-  
25 518 "Approving Arizona Department of Economic Security Intergovernmental  
26 Agreement Amendment No. 2 and the FY 2017 Department of Education One Stop  
27 Division Budget Amendments No. 1 for PY Dislocated Worker, FY Dislocated  
28 Worker, PY Adult/Youth Admin., PY Youth, FY Adult Admin., and FY Adult"  
29 require amendments to ensure proper funding is allocated to provide programs  
30 and services by the One Stop Division; and

31 **WHEREAS,** Resolution No. 15-218 will be amended to reflect the correct project period of  
32 July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016; and

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1 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-242 will be amended to reflect the correct project period of**  
2 **July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-518 will be amended to reflect the correct budget name as "FY**  
4 **2017 Department of Education One Stop Division Budgets for PY Dislocated**  
5 **Worker, FY Dislocated Worker, PY Adult/Youth Admin, PY Youth, FY Adult**  
6 **Admin, and FY Adult"; and**

7 **WHEREAS, another amendment to Resolution No. 16-518 will strike the entire fourth**  
8 **whereas clause therein containing a reference to Resolution No. 16-242; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees**  
10 **have reviewed the amendments to Resolution Nos. 15-218, 16-242, and 16-518**  
11 **and recommend their approval.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends:**

- 13 **1. Resolution No. 15-218 to reflect the correct project period of July 1, 2015**  
14 **to June 30, 2016; and**
- 15 **2. Resolution No. 16-242 to reflect the correct project period of July 1, 2016**  
16 **to June 30, 2017; and**
- 17 **3. Resolution No. 16-518 to correct the name of the budget to "FY 2017**  
18 **Department of Education One Stop Division Budgets for PY Dislocated**  
19 **Worker, FY Dislocated Worker, PY Adult/Youth Admin, PY Youth, FY Adult**  
20 **Admin, and FY Adult", and to strike the entire fourth whereas clause**  
21 **therein containing a reference to Resolution No. 16-242.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23<sup>RD</sup>**  
23 **day of JUNE, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(d)(3)and1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
27 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**  
28 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
