

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Renewal of the Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement
Services between the City of Tolleson and the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-262

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,**
2 **negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation ("Nation") with the Federal, State, and local governments..."**
4 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council previously approved Intergovernmental Agreements for**
6 **Law Enforcement Services between the City of Tolleson and the Tohono O'odham**
7 **Nation by Resolutions No. 15-483 and 16-381; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation desires to renew the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of**
9 **Tolleson, for a term of July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2018, to aid in the various police**
10 **services identified in the Intergovernmental Agreement; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the fee to be paid to the City of Tolleson for their services will remain \$8,750.00**
12 **per month; and**


13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
14 **Council have reviewed this Renewal of the Intergovernmental Agreement for**
15 **Law Enforcement Services and recommend its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
17 **approves the Renewal of the Intergovernmental Agreement for Law**
18 **Enforcement Services.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute the Renewal of the**
21 **Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement Services, provided that any**
22 **amendments shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
23 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23RD**
25 **day of JUNE, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
30 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
