

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2017 Baboquivari District - Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget
Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-293

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Nation,**

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

11 **; and**

12 **WHEREAS, per Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 16-368 the Baboquivari**
13 **District was allocated gaming revenues in the amount of \$2,178,486.42; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Artesia/Little Tucson Community will be decreasing Personnel and Major Capital**
15 **line items. The reduction of the Personnel and Capital line items allowed for an**
16 **increase in the amount of \$30,829.72 in Personnel and Operational line items;**
17 **and**

18 **WHEREAS, FY 2017 Baboquivari District-Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget**
19 **Amendment No. 1 will not affect the budget total of \$207,026.38 nor the overall**
20 **Baboquivari District FY 2017 budget of \$2,377,711.46; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed FY 2017 Baboquivari District-**
22 **Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommends its**
23 **approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves FY**
25 **2017 Baboquivari District-Artesia/Little Tucson Community Budget Amendment**
26 **No. 1 as attached, which will not affect Artesia/Little Tucson Community of**
27 **\$207,026.38, nor the overall Baboquivari District's FY 2017 budget of**
28 **\$2,377,711.46.**

29 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
30 **District Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**
31 **budget, provided that any modification or amendments shall be submitted for**
32 **prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
