

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 17-325

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to promote, protect and**
2 **provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the**
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, there is a need to construct new public roads and improve existing public roads**
6 **within the Nation to promote the health, safety and welfare of the public and**
7 **stimulate economic development; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has done an annual update of the Tohono O'odham**
9 **Nation's Tribal Transportation needs for the purpose of identifying and**
10 **prioritizing needed road construction and improvement projects for fiscal years**
11 **2017 through 2021 on the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Nation's road improvements identified for fiscal years 2017 through 2021**
13 **have been included in the Tohono O'odham Nation's Tribal Transportation**
14 **Improvement Program for transmittal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western**
15 **Regional Office, Division of Transportation to allocate Tribal Transportation**
16 **Program funds; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources, Commerce and Budget and Finance**
18 **Committees has reviewed the Tribal Transportation Improvement Program for**
19 **fiscal years 2017 through 2021 and recommends its approval.**

20 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
21 **approves the Tohono O'odham Nation's Tribal Transportation Improvement**
22 **Program for fiscal years 2017 through 2021.**


23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Chairperson or his designee is authorized to transmit the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Tribal Transportation Improvement Program to the Bureau of**
25 **Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office, Division of Transportation for the**
26 **purpose of acquiring and programming annual Tohono O'odham Nation road**
27 **construction funds and execute all documents required to carry out the intent of**
28 **this Resolution.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
30 **day of JULY, 2017 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and (i)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
33 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
34 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
35 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
