

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Nation Climate Change Adaptation Plan)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-018

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "to manage,**
2 **protect, preserve and regulate the use of the property, wildlife, land, air and**
3 **natural resources (including surface and ground waters) of the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(i)(2));**
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, since 2014, the Water Resources Department, in collaboration with the Center**
7 **for Climate Adaptation Science and Solutions at the University of Arizona's**
8 **Institute of the Environment, has worked to develop a climate change**
9 **adaptation plan for the Nation pursuant to resolutions approving**
10 **intergovernmental agreements between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the**
11 **Arizona Board of Regents, on behalf of the University of Arizona (Resolution No.**
12 **14-265, No. 15-069, No. 15-404, and No. 17-041); and**

13 **WHEREAS, a final draft of the "Tohono O'odham Nation Climate Change Adaptation Plan"**
14 **("Climate Change Adaptation Plan"), which is incorporated by this reference,**
15 **has been completed and which will address vulnerabilities and impacts caused**
16 **by climate change on the Nation; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department has presented the Climate Change Adaptation**
18 **Plan to the Nation's eleven districts and have incorporated comments and**
19 **concerns received from districts and community members; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Water Resources Committees have**
21 **reviewed the Climate Change Adaptation Plan and recommend its approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
23 **Tohono O'odham Nation Climate Change Adaptation Plan in substantially the**
24 **form attached, to address vulnerabilities and impacts caused by climate change**
25 **on the Nation.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Nation's chairperson or any designated official is authorized to**
28 **administer the Tohono O'odham Nation Climate Change Adaptation Plan.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH**
30 **day of JANUARY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,267.0 FOR;**
31 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 817.6 [11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
32 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(i)(2), Article XVII and Article XVIII of the Constitution of the**
33 **Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**
34 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,**
35 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
