

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2018-FY 2019 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-161

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority "to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono**  
3 **O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the Nation**  
4 **and its members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be**  
5 **pursuant to appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance**  
6 **(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**  
8 **2018-FY 2019 Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget, which is incorporated by**  
9 **this reference, in the amount of \$20,000.00 to be funded from the Nation's general**  
10 **fund surplus; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**  
12 **FY 2018-FY 2019 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget and**  
13 **recommend its approval.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
15 **FY 2018-FY 2019 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project Budget**  
16 **effective August 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019 in the amount of**  
17 **\$20,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund surplus.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Legislative**  
19 **Council chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
20 **expend the FY 2018-FY 2019 Legislative Branch Magdalena Visitor Center Project**  
21 **Budget, provided that any modifications shall be submitted to the Budget and**  
22 **Finance Committee for approval on behalf of the Legislative Council and any**  
23 **amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>th</sup>**  
26 **day of MAY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,639.8 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 444.8[09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
28 **by Article VI, Section (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
