

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-167

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2018 Office of Attorney General budget in the amount of \$2,184,736.38 was**
8 **approved by the FY 2018 Executive Branch Tribal Budgets Resolution No. 17-437;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Office of Attorney General has prepared and submitted for review and**
11 **approval its FY 2018 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this**
12 **reference and which (1) adds one new Assistant Attorney General position under**
13 **6000 Salaries Line Item; (2) adds two summer Interns under 6005 Occasional**
14 **Appointments Line Item; and (3) increases the 7355 Professional Services Line to**
15 **establish a Mining Attorney contract, an Ad Hoc Pima/Pinal County Child Welfare**
16 **Attorney contract, and funds an out-of-state Child Welfare Attorney contract in**
17 **Utah; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the FY 2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the**
19 **Office of Attorney General FY 2018 Budget by \$356,580.19 from \$2,184,736.38 to**
20 **\$2,541,316.57; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
22 **2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its**
23 **approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
25 **FY 2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 which includes a**
26 **\$356,580.19 increase from \$2,184,736.38 to \$2,541,316.57 that shall be funded by**
27 **the Nation's general fund.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
29 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
30 **expend the FY 2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1 as**
31 **amended, provided however, that any amendments or modifications shall be**
32 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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(Approving FY 2018 Office of Attorney General Budget Amendment No. 1)

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH day of MAY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,557.4 FOR; 527.2 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
