

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2018 Fee Land Purchase Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-170

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2 negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3 O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian
4 tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or with private
5 persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono
6 O'odham Council" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,
7 Section 1(f)); and

8 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 13-446, the Legislative Council recognized that economic
9 development requires the Nation to conclude agreements and contracts within
10 the scope of their respective authorities and the Council delegated to the
11 Economic Development Delegation authority to consult and negotiate related
12 agreements on the Nation's behalf subject to final approval by Legislative Council
13 resolution; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Economic Development Delegation's authority was affirmed by Resolution
15 No. 18-057, which also authorized the Delegation to make a binding offer that was
16 subsequently accepted; and


17 **WHEREAS,** the Economic Development Delegation, Commerce Committee, Budget and
18 Finance Committee, and Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee
19 recommend that the Legislative Council appropriate \$3,150,000.00 from the
20 Nation's general fund surplus for the FY 2018 Fee Land Purchase Budget, which is
21 incorporated by this reference, and to approve related agreements.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appropriates
23 \$3,150,000.00 from the Nation's General Fund Surplus for the FY 2018 Fee Land
24 Purchase Budget, which is approved.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Nation's Chairman, in consultation with other members of
26 the Economic Development Delegation, is authorized to execute a contract for
27 sale in substantially the form presented to Council in chambers on May 25, 2018,
28 and any other necessary documents, all of which shall remain confidential and
29 shall not be reported or disclosed.


30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 25TH**
31 **day of MAY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
32 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
33 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
34 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
35 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
36 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
